INTERNATIONAL SAFETY MANAGEMENT (ISM) CODE DECLARATIONS DECLARATION OF COMPANY

Under the ISM Code, a company must be declared to the Administration. In accordance with Section 1.12 of IMO Resolution A.741 (18), the ISM Code, "Company" means the Owner of a ship or any other entity such as the Manager, or the Bareboat Charter, who has assumed the responsibility for operation of the ship from the Shipowner and who on assuming such responsibility has agreed to take over all the duties and responsibilities imposed by the Code.
